¹³ And Pilate summoned the chief priests and the rulers and the people,

¹⁴ and said to them, "You brought this man to me as one who incites the people to rebellion, and behold, having examined Him before you, I have found in this man no guilt of what you are accusing Him. ¹⁵ No,

nor has Herod, for he sent Him back to us; and behold, nothing deserving death has been done by Him. ¹⁶ Therefore I will punish Him and release Him." ¹⁷ [Now he was obliged to release to them at the feast one prisoner.] ¹⁸ But they cried out all together, saying, "Away with this man, and release for us Barabbas!" ¹⁹ (He had been thrown

into prison for an insurrection made in the city and for murder.) ²⁰ But again Pilate addressed them, wanting to release Jesus, ²¹ but they kept on calling out, saying, "Crucify, crucify Him!" ²² And he said to them a third time, "Why, what evil has this man done? I have found in Him

no guilt worthy of death; therefore I will punish Him and release

Him." ²³ But they were insistent, with loud voices asking that He be

crucified. And their voices were prevailing. ²⁴ And Pilate pronounced sentence that their demand be granted. ²⁵ And he released the man they

were asking for who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and

murder, but he delivered Jesus to their will.
