## Luke 23:1-12

<sup>1</sup> Then their whole assembly rose up and brought Him before Pilate.

<sup>2</sup> And they began to accuse Him, saying, "We found this man misleading our nation and forbidding to pay taxes to Caesar, and saying that He Himself is Christ, a King." <sup>3</sup> So Pilate asked Him, saying, "Are You the King of the Jews?" And He answered him and said, "You yourself say it." <sup>4</sup> Then Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowds, "I find no guilt in this man." <sup>5</sup> But they kept on insisting, saying, "He stirs up the people, teaching all over Judea, starting from Galilee even as far as this place." <sup>6</sup> Now when Pilate heard this, he asked whether the man was a Galilean. <sup>7</sup> And when he learned that He belonged to Herod's jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who himself also was in Jerusalem in those days. <sup>8</sup> Now when Herod saw Jesus, he rejoiced greatly; for he had wanted to see Him for a long time, because he had been hearing about Him and was hoping to see some sign performed by Him. <sup>9</sup> And he questioned Him at some length, but He answered him nothing. <sup>10</sup> And the chief priests and the scribes were standing there, vehemently accusing Him. <sup>11</sup> And Herod with his soldiers, after treating Him with contempt and mocking Him, dressed Him in a bright robe and sent Him back to Pilate. <sup>12</sup> Now Herod and Pilate became friends with one another that very day; for before they had been at enmity with each other.
