<sup>27</sup> And after that He went out and noticed a tax collector named Levi sitting in the tax office, and He said to him, "Follow Me." <sup>28</sup> And he left everything behind, and rose up and began to follow Him. <sup>29</sup> And Levi gave a big reception for Him in his house; and there was a great crowd of tax collectors and other people who were reclining at the table with them. <sup>30</sup> And the Pharisees and their scribes began grumbling at His disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with the tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>31</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them, "It is not those who are well who need a physician, but those who are sick. <sup>32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance." <sup>33</sup> And they said to Him, "The disciples of John often fast and offer prayers, the disciples of the Pharisees also do likewise, but Yours eat and drink." <sup>34</sup> And Jesus said to them, "Can you make the attendants of the bridegroom fast while the bridegroom is with them? <sup>35</sup> But the days will come; and when the bridegroom is taken away from them, then they will fast in those days." <sup>36</sup> And He was also telling them a parable: "No one tears a piece of cloth from a new garment and puts it on an old garment; otherwise he will both tear the new and the piece from the new will not match the old. <sup>37</sup> And no one puts new wine into old wineskins; otherwise the new wine will burst the skins and it will be spilled out, and the skins will be ruined. <sup>38</sup> But new wine must be put into fresh wineskins. <sup>39</sup> And no one, after drinking old wine wishes for new; for he says, 'The old is good enough.'"
